WATER ASSOCIATION

The water hydrant on Pepperwood Court will be replaced hopefully in the next few weeks. Homes north of Kellenberger's corner will probably be without water for a full day with a boil order after. You will be notified ahead of the actual date if you are affected.

The chlorinator pump broke down and we are currently using a temporary one not intended for our system. This pump should be replaced soon with no interruption of service or boil order.

An air release valve will soon be installed at the wellhead which should provide some relief for the air collecting at high points in the system.
