## INLAND PHONE MEETING

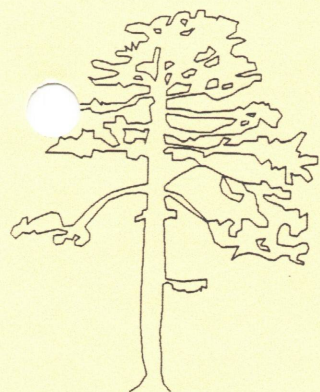
