## PET CONTEST

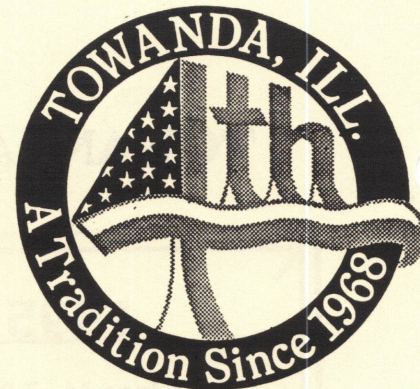
Judging is at 6:00 pm at the Tennis Courts, South Park.

Business, neighborhood or family floats, antique vehicles, horses, groups and individual bicyclers and walkers are invited to participate.

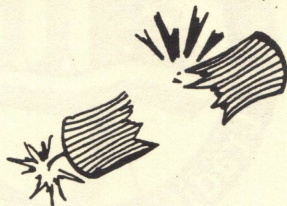
