

Last month the little green house right before reaching Indian Creek Subdivision caught on fire and was declared a total loss. The fire is still under investigation with the possibility of arson being the cause. If the fact that a neighborhood home burnt isn't enough to get your attention, maybe the story behind the owner will.

Jason Collins, a twenty year old, is the owner of that home. He was raised in that house by his mother, Janet and father, Alton. Janet passed away a few years ago and left Jason, a mere child, and his elderly father behind. It wasn't easy for them, but with the help, support and friendship of many people, several right here in our subdivision, Jason and Alton survived their loss.

This year Jason lost his father to cancer. Just barely out of his teenage years, he had lost both parents and was at a loss as to what to do next.

An opportunity arose that Jason felt would help him in his decision making. He went out west in May to work in the fields for a gentleman. While he was still out west, this fire has destroyed everything Jason had in his life--his home, his belongings, his furniture and appliances, his father's belongings, his mother's belongings. Absolutely everything other than 2 bags of worn out clothing he was wearing to harvest in was destroyed! A big chunk of Jason's spirit was destroyed also.

Jason did have insurance but the very small amount isn't going to provide him with the items he will need to continue living in Towanda, the only option he wants to consider or think about. With the help of his brother and sister-in-law, Larry & Janet Collins in Towanda, and a dear friend, Kathleen Emery, a neighbor whom Jason refers to as "Grandma", he is hopefully going to get all the paperwork settled and once the investigation has been completed, Jason can begin to rebuild his life. He will need lots and lots of help, though.

Anyone interested in making a cash donation, please make checks payable to Jason Collins and send to Vicky Hogan. Anyone wishing to provide household items or anyone having any ideas on what can be done to help Jason, please give Vicky a call and she will contact Jason so that arrangements can be made. Getting the insurance money and deciding what can be built on the land Jason owns will be the first step, but we would like to keep this fresh in everyone's minds that would like to help. Helping a neighbor is only right. Wouldn't you want someone there for you if the circumstances ever occurred? Think about it and help us help Jason! Thank you in advance!


