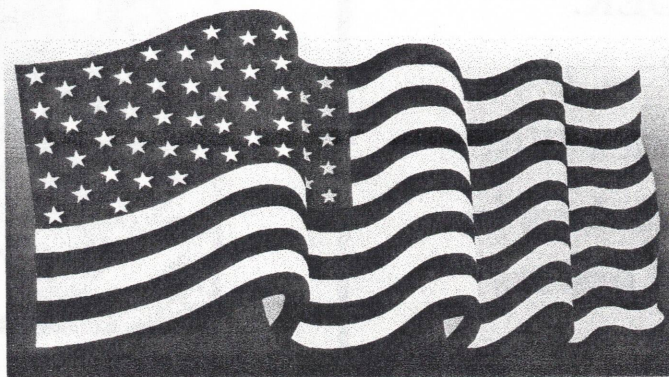
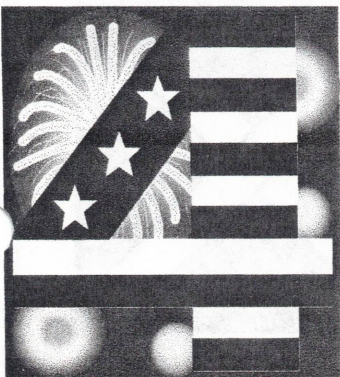
## Updates

I can bake cakes for any occasion. I have numerous shaped pans plus the traditional 1/4 and 1/2 sheet cake pans.

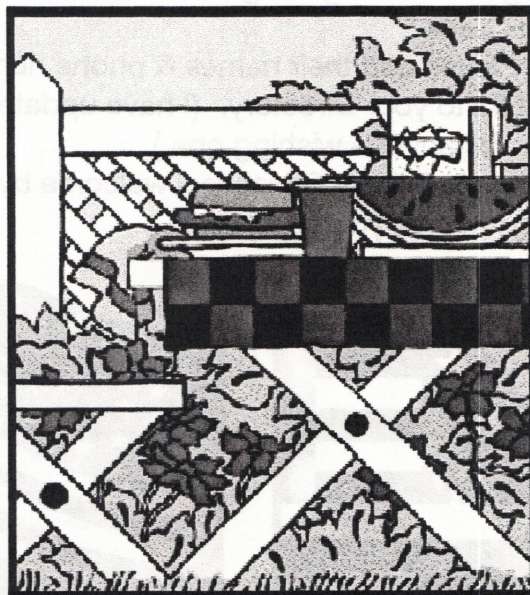
