## Water Tower Piping/Valves Repairs

We are going to replace the main water pipes and valves in the water tower base when we have a break in the weather. The pipes and valves have significant corrosion because of their age (over 40 years old) and the effects of having chlorination treatment in the water tower base until we built the chemical building. We had a break in one of the main pipes a couple of years ago which flooded the water tower base and caused disruption to our water service.

This work will require shutting off water service for most of a day followed by a boil order for 2-3 business days. More detailed information will be provided by email closer to the time this maintenance will be performed. We will work with the plumber to limit water service disruption as much as possible and not shutoff water until everyone has the chance to go to work/school. Please plan to have some drinking water available and maybe a bucket or two for toilet flushing.

Replacing this equipment along with other recent projects (chemical building construction, water tower refurbishing and well pump/drop pipe replacement) puts the major components of our water system in good condition. We are also working with Corn Belt Electric to have them replace the power line to the wellhead. This line currently runs from near the water tower through the woods and under the creek to the wellhead. Corn Belt Electric has said they can reroute the line from near the bridge, along the gravel road to the wellhead.

## Water Hydrant Flushing Schedule - 2025

The six water hydrants located in Indian Creek subdivision will be flushed on the dates listed below. Water hydrants are flushed in order to reduce the build-up of sediments in our water system. This is an important process for improving water quality. Our water operator will flush one hydrant at a time and allow it to run for 10-15 minutes (the next in line hydrant is opened concurrently for a brief period to keep water flowing through the system). Water pressure in our system's lines is maintained by the 35,000 gallons of water in our tower, however, pressure in home lines will be reduced during flushing much like when multiple faucets are opened in your homes. Flushing the hydrants will also stir up sediments so please follow the procedures listed below:

- Do not run water during the flushing time period.
- Following flushing, run water through faucets until clear. We recommend this be done by-passing any treatment/filtering system in your home because of the increased sediment stirred up during the flushing process.

Please mark your calendars with the dates listed below. Flushing will be done between 5:00 a.m. and 6:30 a.m. weather permitting. Hydrants will not be flushed in freezing conditions or other inclement weather.
